Young Athletes Club Open Meeting on Sat 27th May 2017

It was an afternoon of sunshine and excitement at the track as 200 young athletes age 5 to 12 years competed to win medals in sprinting, long jump, middle distance and throwing. Most came from the home team **Young Athletes Club** but many came from clubs across Surrey including Bracknell, Camberley, Epsom, Waverley, Walton, Woking and Dorking. Here are just a few highlights from the meeting;



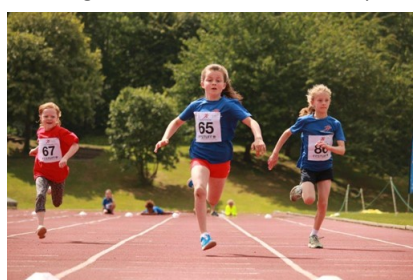
The U11 boys was the biggest age group with 45 competitors. Ray Runnicles from YAC was a clear winner with 255 points, his best score coming in the 600m where he had the fastest time of all in 1.55mins.



Louis Simmons from YAC was third with the best throw of the day in 40.35m. George Christmas and Ollie Billingham made 4th and 5th for YAC.

Arabella Wilson from Young Athletes Club ran away with the win in the U11 girls taking the gold medal by 30 points with a superb 600m in under 2mins and a long jump of 3.65m. Esme Finch from YAC came a strong second with a score of 200 points across all 4 events closely

The youngest competitors in the under 7s age group were given a huge cheer by the enthusiastic crowd when they competed in their 50m and 150m races. Jessica Fletcher won both races in the U7 girls and just wanted to carry on running as she raced passed the finish line. Sophie Driver won the silver in the 150m with Hollie Ellis in 3rd.



followed by Elin Roberts also from YAC who was 3rd for bronze with 199 points and Orlaith Byrne in 5th on 191 points. Elise Christian from YAC was the outright winner of the U9 girl's event with a magnificent throw of 28.32m and the fastest 300m in 56s.



In the U7 boys, Daniel Amos took the gold in the 50m sprint with Lucas Newton in second.

These two boys then swapped results in the 150m with Lucas taking the gold and Daniel silver. Sam Greayer Smith was the bronze winner in the 50m
